Soccer league

Structure a league for young boys

Mavu has welcomed the donation of Marianum Highschool with the utmost gratitude. Therefore we would like to send regular updates of how we spent the money. The roughly eleven thousand Euro is a lot of money for our organization. We are therefore able to split it up and use it for different projects.

1. Tshakhuma soccer youth league. 40%

This December 2014 Mavu is hosting a tournament for the community Tshakhuma, situated in the North-East of South Africa. The challenge in this community is that only senior teams are structured. Very little attention is given to the youth. It is our intention to assist this community with setting up a league for the U13 and U15 teams. Finances will go to basic equipment, a small stipend for a local coordinator and courses or workshops for local coaches. Around 10 soccer teams will therefore be able to play an official match every second week, throughout the whole of 2015.

2. School Sport Competition. 30%

During 2014 Mavu started a school sport project in Masia, a community not far from Tshakhuma. Several volunteers are trained to work in these schools as coaches. A german sport student from a university in Münster assisted during some of these workshops. The next step is to establish a competition between these schools. Part of the

finances are going to be used for basic sport equipment and transport for the competitions. 7 schools will therefore be able to compete every second week in 5 different sporting codes.

3. Elite Athlete support. 15%.

We secured a smaller portion of the budget for the assistance of Muzi Maluleke. Muzi is a young bodybuilder and SA's national junior champion. His life story is extraordinary. This sport is all about self determination, dedication and a lot of hard work. Muzi is from a truly disadvantaged background, but through his sport he managed to study, and travel. It changed his life. He currently has a sponsor. However, this sponsor is not fully covering his demands as he has a strict diet to stick to. This project is part of Mavu's program that supports elite athletes who are not able to succeed without financial and personal support.

4. Project implementation. 10 -15%.

As any other organization, the projects that Mavu implement deserve quality attention. A small portion of the donation will therefore be used to cover part of the project coordination.

We would like to update Marianum about these projects every second month. We will send a report with the details of progress made.
