DESCRIPTION

You have already spent a few exciting days in New York and now want to calm down a bit or just want to enjoy a relaxing day? Then you got the right tour.

For a very relaxing day in New York, we will first go to the largest and greenest park: **Central Park**.

This is the start and the end of this tour. We stay there for 2 hours before we walk around 11

minutes together to **Rockefeller Center**.

We stay at the top of the rock for an hour.

Here you can enjoy the view and have a snack. After that, we take the subway for about half an hour to enjoy a **ride on the water**.

New York is surrounded by water, and within 3 and a half hours we will be able to see a lot of the city, such as the **Statue of Liberty**.

When we get back from the boat, we will take the subway again to **Alvin Ailey Dance Studio**, this will take an hour but when we're there we have time to watch the dancers. At the final end we walk back to **Central Park** where we can eat something together and chat for the rest of the time.

ATTRACTIONS

CENTRAL PARK

Central Park is known as the "Green Lungs of New York". Tourists and New Yorkers come together to spend time in nature, even in a big city like New York. The park has an area of 349.5 hectares and took 16 years to be built. Particularly popular for taking walks, reading books or picnicking with friends. A great activity for our relaxing day in New York!



ROCKEFELLER CENTER

Rockefeller Center is 849 feet (259 meters) high and has 70 floors. We will spend time on the observation deck, which is on the highest floor and is also known as "The top of the Rock". From there we will get to see a breathtaking view of New York City. The building consists of several, to be precise, 21 interconnected business skyscrapers.

TICKETS/EQUIPMENT

For this tour you don't need to pay anything like tickets for the subway or for example the entrance tickets to the Rockefeller Center. However, you should bring a bag with a few snacks and drinks. Picnic blankets for Central Park and board games or playing cards are provided by our team. Also make sure that you always have your phone with you so that our team can reach out to you in an emergency.

BOAT TOUR/STATUE OF LIBERTY

Statue of Liberty. Probably the most famous here in New York. With her proud 152.55 feet (46.5 meters) the green lady is well seen. The statue is a gift from the French people and applies to freedom. Hence the name. Since 1886 she is standing on the small island in the middle of the water - a popular attraction that is combined with a relaxing boat tour.



ALVIN AILEY DANCE THEATER

Alvin Ailey American dance theater became internationally known especially after her touring. It was founded in 1958. Through the touring of the studio, modern dance became more popular all over the world. The perfect place to switch off and watch the dancers and listen to the slow music.
